

JOINT COMMUNIQUÉ

On the establishment of diplomatic relations

Between

The Republic of Botswana

And

The Republic of Burundi

The Government of the Republic of Botswana and
the Government of the Republic of Burundi,

Being desirous of strengthening the friendly relations existing between the two countries and promoting mutually beneficial co-operation on the basis of mutual respect, and the principles of sovereignty, territorial integrity and non-interference in the internal affairs of other states,

Guided by the principles and purposes of the Charter of the United Nations and the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18 April 1961,

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations at ambassadorial level with effect from the date of signature of the present Joint Communiqué,

In witness thereof, the undersigned Plenipotentiaries, duly authorized by their respective Governments, have signed the Joint Communiqué.

Done in New York, United States of America on March 13, 2007 in duplicate, each in English and French language, both texts being equally authentic.

COMMUNIQUE CONJOINT
