JOINT COMMUNIQUÉ

On the establishment of diplomatic relations

Between

Saint Vincent and the Grenadines

And

Botswana

The Government of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines and The Government of Botswana

Being desirous of strengthening the friendly relations existing between the two countries and promoting mutually beneficial co-operation on the basis of mutual respect and the principles of sovereignty, territorial integrity and non-interference in the internal affairs of other states,

Guided by the principles and purposes of the Charter of the United Nations and the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18 April 1961,

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations at ambassadorial level with effect from the date of signature of the present Joint Communiqué,

In witness thereof, the undersigned Plenipotentiaries, duly authorized by their respective Governments, have signed the Joint Communiqué.
