Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 46th meeting, on 7 December 1991, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/46/57) on the programme budget implications of the draft resolutions A/46/L.27 and A/46/L.28. The related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions was presented orally by its Chairman.

2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this **item** are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/46/SR.46).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolutions A/46/L.27 and A/46/L.28 their implementation would not require any modification of the programme of work under sections 6 (Special political questionst regional cooperation; trusteeship and decolonization) and **51** (Public information). It further decided to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt the draft resolutions A/46/L.27 and A/46/L.28 no additional appropriation would be required under the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1992-1993.
