1. At its 46th meeting, on 7 December 1991, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/46/40) on the programme budget implications of the draft resolution recommended by the First Committee in paragraph 8 of its report (A/46/678), and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (A/46/7/Add.11).
2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/46/SR.46).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt the draft resolution recommended by the First

Committee in paragraph 8 of its report, 1/ and the Conference on the Indian Ocean be convened at Colombo, it is the understanding of the Secretary-General that the host Government would defray the actual additional costs directly or indirectly involved in meeting at Colombo, consistent with the provisions of General Assembly resolution 40/243 of 18 December 1985.
