Letter dated 13 April 1987 from the Chargé d'affaires a.i. of the
Permanent Mission of Pakistan to the United Nations addressed to
the Secretary-General

Further to our letter dated 30 March 1987 (A/42/190-S/18770), I have the honour to report to you a serious incident in violation of Pakistan territory from the Afghanistan side that occurred on 8 April 1987. On that date, at 2010 hours (Pakistan standard time), the Afghan armed forces fired five tank rounds that landed in area Khar Galī approximately 8 kilometres west of Landikotal in Khyber Agency, as a result of which two Pakistan nationals were injured.

The Afghan Chargé d'affaires was summoned to the Foreign Office at Islamabad on 13 April 1987 and a strong protest was lodged with him over this unprovoked attack. The Chargé d'affaires was asked to inform his authorities that, if such

attacks did not cease, the entire responsibility for the serious consequences would rest on the Kabul authorities.

I request you to have this letter circulated as a document of the General Assembly, under items 31, 73, 131, 136 and 140 of the preliminary list, and of the Security Council.
