ANNOTATED PROVISIONAL AGENDA AND ORGANIZATION OF THE WORK OF THE SESSION

Note by the Executive Director

Item 1

Opening of the session

1. The fourteenth session of the Governing Council will be opened by the President of the Council at its thirteenth session or, in his absence, by one of the other officers of the Council at its thirteenth session.

Item 2

Organization of the session

(a) Election of officers

2. The Governing Council elects its officers at the beginning of each session in accordance with rule 18 of the Council's rules of procedure, which provides inter alia that, in doing so, the Council shall have due regard to the principle of equitable geographical representation and that the offices of the President and the Rapporteur shall be subject to rotation among the five regional groups of States. 1/

- 3. Should the Council decide to establish a sessional committee of the whole, as suggested in paragraph 6 below, the committee will elect its own officers, with the exception of its chairman, in accordance with rule 61 of the rules of procedures. In the past, the Council has designated the chairmen of its sessional committees from the vice-presidents of the Council. As the Council, in its decision 11/2, paragraph 2 (b), decided there should be only one sessional committee of the whole, the Council may wish to consider designating from the three vice-presidents of the session one to serve as chairman of the committee of the whole, one to assist the President, especially when Fund and administration matters are being dealt with in plenary meeting, and one to chair the informal drafting group.
 - (b) Agenda and organization of work of the session (UNEP/GC.14/1 and Add.1)
- 4. The provisional agenda for the fourteenth session, as approved by the Council at its thirteenth session, $\underline{2}$ / was distributed on 23 April 1986 (UNEP/GC.14/1).
- 5. The Executive Director recommends that the Council should deal with the following items of the provisional agenda primarily in plenary meetings: item 4 (Executive Director's reports); item 5 (State-of-the-environment reports); item 6 (Co-ordination questions); item 7 (Report of the World Commission on Environment and Development); and item 8 (Environmental Perspective to the Year 2000 and Beyond). Additionally, items 11 (The Environment Fund) and 12 (Other administrative and financial matters) would also be dealt with in plenary meetings.
- In keeping with Council decision 11/2, paragraph 2 (b), the Council may wish to establish, under rule 60 of the rules of procedure, a sessional committee of the whole. The Executive Director proposes that the committee of the whole would deal primarily with item 10 of the provisional agenda (Programme matters). Further, in line with the recommendation made at the pre-sessional informal consultations with Governments in January 1979 to the effect that some additional items or special items could be allocated to sessional committees, the Executive Director proposes that the Council should consider also assigning to the committee of the whole item 9 of the provisional agenda (Implementation of the Plan of Action to Combat Desertification), which the committee may wish to consider when it reviews the activities of the Programme on arid and semi-arid lands ecosystems and desertification control. The Council may also wish to consider assigning to the committee the task of considering the joint report of the Executive Directors of UNEP and United Nations Centre for Human Settlements (Habitat) on co-operation between UNEP and the United Nations Centre for Human Settlements (Habitat) (UNEP/GC.14/7), submitted under item 6 (a), when the committee reviews the activities of the Programme on health and human settlements.
- 7. A chart illustrating the organization of work of the fourteenth session, as proposed by the Executive Director, is contained in annex I. The Executive Director is proposing that immediately after the formal opening of the session in the morning of Monday, 8 June, the Council should devote two meetings both to item 7 (Report of the World Commission on Environment and Development) and to item 8 (Environmental Perspective to the Year 2000 and Beyond) of the provisional agenda, to allow sufficient time for consultations and negotiations on these subjects among and between the various regional groups. The Council may wish to consider expanding the informal drafting group when it considers the formulation of draft decisions on these two related items.

8. Annex III contains a list of the relevant documents, together with their symbols, submitted under each item of the provisional agenda, and the Executive Director's proposals as to the forum in which they should be discussed.

Item 3

Credentials of representatives

9. In accordance with rule 17 of the rules of procedure, the credentials of representatives at the fourteenth session of the Council will be examined by the Bureau, which will report thereon to the Council. It should be noted that, under rule 16, each member of the Council is to be represented by one accredited representative, who may be accompanied by such alternate representatives and advisers as may be required.

Item 4

Executive Director's reports (UNEP/GC.14/2, chaps. I and II and annex I; UNEP/GC.14/3, chaps. I and II and annex I; UNEP/GC.14/4 and Add. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6*).

- 10. In compliance with Council decision 13/3, paragraph 1, the Executive Director is submitting to the Council at its fourteenth session two Annual Reports, one covering the year 1985 (UNEP/GC.14/2) and the other covering 1986 (UNEP/GC.14/3 and Add.1*). The Reports touch on a number of items of the provisional agenda, including items 4, 6, 9, 10, 11 and 12. Chapters I ("The year in retrospect") and II ("Intergovernmental legislation of relevance to UNEP") are relevant to item 4 of the provisional agenda.
- 11. In his introductory report (UNEP/GC.14/4), the Executive Director provides a general overview of developments relating to UNEP. There are also a number of related reports which are being submitted to the Council as addenda to that report:
 - (a) Environmental impacts of <u>apartheid</u> on Black agriculture in South Africa (UNEP/GC.14/4/Add.1);
 - (b) "Periodicity and duration of Governing Council sessions" (UNEP/GC.14/4/Add.2);
 - (c) "The clearing-house experiment" (UNEP/GC.14/4/Add.3 and Corr.1);
 - (d) "Future orientation of the work of UNEP" (UNEP/GC.14/4/Add.4);
 - (e) "Environment and financial institutions" (UNEP/GC.14/4/Add.5);
 - (f) "Follow-up of international conferences related to the environment" (UNEP/GC.14/4/Ald.6*).

^{*} Documents marked with an asterisk are not expected to be submitted in time to comply with the six-week rule.

12. The Executive Director's introductory statement will complement, and be issued as an addendum to, the introductory report.

Item 5

State-of-the-environment reports (UNEP/GC.14/5 and Add.1; UNEP/GC.14/6 and Add. 1 and 2 and Corr.1; UNEP/GC.14/9; UNEP/GC.14/10 and UNEP/GC.14/11 and Corr.1)

- 13. In response to Council decision 13/3, paragraph 6, the Executive Director is submitting two state-of-the-environment reports to the Council. The 1986 state-of-the-environment report (UNEP/GC.14/5) is on the subject of "environment and health", and the addendum to that report contains suggested action by the Governing Council. The 1987 report (UNEP/GC.14/6), on the state of the world environment, presents a comprehensive survey of the State of the global environment since the first such comprehensive report was published in 1982. The 1987 report utilizes, inter alia, the data and results of assessments available through the Global Environmental Monitoring System (GEMS), as called for by Governing Council in paragraph 4 of decision 13/9 D. The first addendum to that report contains suggested action by the Governing Council, while proposed topics for the 1988 state-of-the-environment report are listed in UNEP/GC.14/6/Add.2 and Corr.1.
- 14. In document UNEP/GC.14/9, the Executive Director is submitting a report on emerging environmental issues (including municipal solid waste and aquaculture) as called for by the Governing Council in decision 13/9 B, paragraph 2. In document UNEP/GC.14/10, the Executive Director is submitting a report on major environmental events, prepared in response to Governing Council decision 11/1, section II, paragraph 5. In document UNEP/GC.14/11, the Executive Director is reporting on the implementation of Governing Council decision 13/23 on state-of-the-environment reports in the developing countries.

Item 6

Co-ordination questions (UNEP/GC.14/2, chap. III; UNEP/GC.14/3, chap. III; UNEP/GC.14/7; UNEP/GC.14/8 and UNEP/GC.14/12)

15. In the third chapter of both his Annual Reports (UNEP/GC.14/2 and UNEP/GC.14/3), the Executive Director describes current developments with respect to the co-ordinating and catalytic role of UNEP. Document UNEP/GC.14/7 contains the joint progress report of the Executive Directors of UNEP and the United Nations Centre for Human Settlements (Habitat) on co-operation between UNEP and the Centre as called for by the Council in decision 13/12, paragraph 5. The Executive Director of the Centre will address the Governing Council on the subject. It is proposed that the joint progress report should be discussed in the committee of the whole, under agenda item 10 (Programme matters) under the budget line "Health and human settlements". The 1985 report of the Administrative Committee on Co-ordination to the Council is contained in document UNEP/GC.14/8, while the Committee's report for 1986 is in document UNEP/GC.14/12. It is proposed that section II of both documents, dealing with co-ordination and follow-up of the implementation of the Plan of Action to Combat Desertification, should be discussed in the committee of the whole concurrently with agenda item 9 (Implementation of the Plan of Action to Combat Desertification).

Report of the World Commission on Environment and Development (UNEP/GC.14/13 and Add.1*)

16. In his note (UNEP/GC.14/13), the Executive Director transmits to the Governing Council the report of the World Commission on Environment and Development. Pursuant to paragraph 11 of General Assembly resolution, on matters within the mandate and purview of UNEP, that report should in the first instance be considered by the Governing Council "for transmission to the General Assembly together with its comments, and for use as basic material in the preparation for adoption by the Assembly of the Environmental Perspective". As an addendum to UNEP/GC.14/13, the Executive Director is submitting the report of the Intergovernmental Inter-sessional Preparatory Committee on the report of the World Commission.

Item 8

Environmental Perspective to the Year 2000 and Beyond (UNEP/GC.14/14*)

17. The Environmental Perspective to the Year 2000 and Beyond prepared by the Intergovernmental Inter-sessional Preparatory Committee which was established by the Council in its decision 11/3 is submitted to the Council in document UNEP/GC.14/14* for its consideration and approval for subsequent transmission for adoption by the General Assembly, in compliance with paragraph 11 of Assembly resolution 38/161.

Item 9

Implementation of the Plan of Action to Combat Desertification (UNEP/GC.14/2, chap. IV, paras. 234-271; UNEP/GC.14/3, chap. IV, paras. 222-278; UNEP/GC.14/15; UNEP/GC.14/8, section II, and UNEP/GC.14/12, section II).

18. In his Annual Reports for 1985 and 1986 (UNEP/GC.14/2 and UNEP/GC.14/3), the Executive Director reports, inter alia, on the co-ordination and follow-up of the implementation of the Plan of Action to Combat Desertification during those years. The Reports also describe progress in the implementation of the Plan of Action in the Sudano-Sahelian region over the same period. These reports are intended to form the basis for the Council's reports to the General Assembly, through the Economic and Social Council, in response to paragraph 9 of General Assembly resolution 40/198 A and paragraph 9 of resolution 40/198 B. Further, it is proposed to take up the second sections of the two reports of the Administrative Committee on Co-ordination (UNEP/GC.14/8 and UNEP/GC.14/12) under this item, as those sections deal with the co-ordination and follow-up of the implementation of the Plan of Action. Finally, in document UNEP/GC.14/15, the Executive Director is presenting some specific policy issues regarding the Plan of Action that call for guidance and action by the Council.

Item 10

Programme matters (UNEP/GC.14/2, chap. IV, and annexes III and IV; UNEP/GC.14/3, chap. IV and annexes III and IV; UNEP/GC.14/3/Add.1*, chap. II; UNEP/GC.14/16; UNEP/GC.14/17 and Add.1* and 2*; UNEP/GC.14/18 and UNEP/GC/INFORMATION/11/Rev.1/Supplement 1; UNEP/GC.14/19; UNEP/GC.14/25*; and UNEP/GC.14/L.1*).

- 19. Chapter IV of the Annual Reports (UNEP/GC.14/2 and UNEP/GC.14/3) describes the performance of the Programme in 1985 and 1986. These chapters are supplemented by lists of publications and papers (annex III) and meetings (annex IV) of UNEP in 1985 and 1986. Chapter II of Part One of the 1986 Annual Report (UNEP/GC.14/3/Add.1*) reports on the implementation of the approved programme budget during 1986.
- 20. Document UNEP/GC.14/16 contains the proposed programme budget for 1988-1989, in compliance with Council decision 13/15, while document UNEP/GC.14/17 and addenda present programme matters that require guidance by the Governing Council.
- 21. In document UNEP/GC.14/25*, the Executive Director is submitting a report on shared natural resources and legal aspects of offshore mining and drilling, in response to Governing Council decision 13/18, section IV. This report is intended to form the basis for the Council's report to the General Assembly at its forty-second session, in accordance with resolution 40/200.
- 22. In document UNEP/GC.14/18 the Council will have before it the report of the Executive Director on international conventions and protocols in the field of the environment. Associated with this report will be an updated supplement to the "Register of international treaties and other agreements in the field of the environment" (UNEP/GC/INFORMATION/11/Rev.1), which was submitted to the Council at its thirteenth session. This report and the supplement represent the Executive Director's response to Governing Council decision 24 (III) and General Assembly resolution 3436 (XXX), in which the Council and Assembly asked to be kept informed annually of progress made in securing adherence to agreements concerning the environment.
- 23. In document UNEP/GC.14/L.1*, the Executive Director is submitting a report of the Joint Inspection Unit on the contribution of the organizations of the United Nations system to the conservation and management of cultural and natural heritage in Africa.
- 24. In compliance with decision 12/11, the Executive Director is submitting to the Council an updated list of selected environmentally harmful chemical substances, processes and phenomena of global significance (UNEP/GC.14/19).

The Environment Fund (UNEP/GC.14/2, chap. V and annex V; UNEP/GC.14/3/Add.1*, chap. I and annex; UNEP/GC.14/20; UNEP/GC.14/21; UNEP/GC.14/22 and Add.1*; UNEP/GC.14/L.2*; UNEP/GC.14/L.3*; UNEP/GC.14/L.4; and UNEP/GC.14/L.5*).

25. Chapter V of the Annual Report for 1985 (UNEP/GC.14/2) deals with the implementation of the Fund programme in 1985, including the resources available and their utilization. This information is augmented by the financial tables in annex V to the report. Chapter I of Part Two of the 1986 Annual Report (UNEP/GC.14/3/Add.1*) contains relevant information for 1986 and is also augmented by the financial tables in the annex to that report. Lists of Fund projects approved during 1985 and 1986 have appeared in Report on New Projects 1985 and Report on New Projects 1986, respectively, which have been circulated to all Governments.

- 26. Document UNEP/GC.14/22 contains a report on the management of the Environment Fund. In the addendum to that report (UNEP/GC.14/22/Add.1*) the information is supplemented by a report on developments relating to the Fund from 1 January to 31 March 1987.
- 27. Document UNEP/GC.14/20 contains a performance report on the programme and programme support costs budget of the Environment Fund for the biennium 1986-1987. The Council will also have before it the comments of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions on that report (UNEP/GC.14/L.2*).
- 28. Document UNEP/GC.14/21 contains the proposed budget for programme and programme support costs of the Environment Fund for the biennium 1988-1989. The Council will also have before it the comments of the Advisory Committee on the proposed budget (UNEP/GC.14/L.3*).
- 29. The financial report and audited accounts of the Environment Fund for the biennium 1984-1985 ended 31 December 1985 will be submitted to the Council in document UNEP/GC.14/L.4. The financial report and interim accounts (unaudited) for the first year of the biennium 1986-1987 ended 31 December 1986, will be submitted to the Council for information in document UNEP/GC.14/L.5*.

Other administrative and financial matters (UNEP/GC.14/2, chap. VI and annex II; UNEP/GC.14/3, chap. V and annex II; UNEP/GC.14/23*; UNEP/GC.14/24).

- 30. In chapter VI of his 1985 Annual Report (UNEP/GC.14/2), the Executive Director describes the basic management and administration of the UNEP secretariat. Supplementing this chapter is annex II to the report, showing the geographical distribution of the professional staff of UNEP as at 31 December 1985. The corresponding information for 1986 is contained in chapter V and annex II of the 1986 Annual Report (UNEP/GC.14/3).
- 31. In document UNEP/GC.14/23*, the Executive Director is proposing action on a number of trust funds and other funds managed by him under the rules of the Environment Fund. Annual reports on the management of trust funds in 1985 and 1986 are to be found in chapter V of the 1985 Annual Report (UNEP/GC.14/2) and in chapter I of Part Two of the 1986 Annual Report (UNEP/GC.14/3/Add.1*).
- 32. In response to Governing Council decision 13/33, the Executive Director is also submitting a report on additional sources of financing (UNEP/GC.14/24).

Provisional agenda, date and place of the fifteenth session of the Governing Council

- 33. Rule 4 of the rules of procedure provides that regular sessions of the Governing Council shall be held at UNEP headquarters, unless otherwise decided by the Council at a previous session.
- 34. The Executive Director will propose a provisional agenda and dates for the fifteenth session of the Council. In addition, should the Council accept the Executive Director's proposals for biennial sessions of the Council, contained in document UNEP/GC.14/4/Add.2, including the proposal to hold a special session in early 1988 to consider the draft system-wide medium-term environment programme for 1990-1995 and the UNEP chapter of the United Nations medium-term plan 1990-1995, the Executive Director will also propose a provisional agenda and dates for that special session.

Item 14

Other business

35. No subjects having been proposed under this item, no documentation is planned.

Item 15

Adoption of the report

36. Section I, paragraph 3, of General Assembly resolution 2997 (XXVII) provides that the Governing Council shall report annually to the General Assembly through the Economic and Social Council. It is suggested that the Council's report should be succinct and action-oriented, omitting unnecessary background material and annexes.
