I. INTRODUCTION

- 1. At its 3rd meeting, on 20 September 1991, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its forty-sixth session the item entitled "Programme budget for the biennium 1990-1991" and to allocate it to the Fifth Committee.
- 2. The Committee considered this item at its 36th, 48th and 54th meetings on 18 November and 10 and 17 December. It had before it the following documents:
- (a) Report of the Secretary-General on the establishment of a United Nations information centre at Windhoek (A/C.5/46/14). The related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions was presented orally by its Chairman;
- (b) Report of the Secretary-General on standards of accommodation for air travel (A/C.5/46/3) and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (A/46/748);
- (c) Report of the Secretary-General on the programme budget performance of the United Nations for the biennium 1990-1991 (A/C.5/46/46). The report of the Advisory Committee was presented orally by its Chairman.

- (c) Requests the Secretary-General to submit to the General Assembly at its forty-seventh session a review/evaluation of the current system together with the specific proposals.

DRAFT DECISION III

Effects of inflation and currency fluctuation

The General Assembly

- (a) Recalling paragraphs 8, 9 and 10 of its resolution 43/214 of 21 December 1988, on the need for a comprehensive and satisfactory solution to the problem of controlling the effects of inflation and currency fluctuation on the budget of the United Nations;
- (b) Requests the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions to resume consideration of this issue and to report as appropriate to the General Assembly at its forty-seventh session;
- (c) Also recalls, inter alia, paragraph 11 of annex I to resolution 41/213 of 19 December 1986, which stipulated that, pending the comprehensive and satisfactory solution mentioned above, fluctuations in rates of exchange and inflation shall continue to be treated in accordance with established procedures and under the relevant provisions of the Financial Regulations and Rules.
