Appointment of a member of the Board of Auditors

## Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Mahmoud BARIMANI (Islamic Republic of Iran)

- 1. At its 49th meeting, on 11 December 1991, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/46/103) concerning the vacancy in the membership of the United Nations Board of Auditors that will occur as a result of the expiration of the term of office of one of its members on 30 June 1992.
- 2. The Comptroller and Auditor General of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland was nominated by his Government for appointment to fill the vacancy arising on the Board of Auditors (A/C.5/46/53).
- 3. The Fifth Committee decided, by acclamation, to recommend the Comptroller and Auditor General of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland for appointment as a member of the Board of Auditors for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 July 1992.

## RECOMMENDATION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

4. The Fifth Committee recommends that the General Assembly should appoint the Comptroller and Auditor General of the United Lingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland as a member of the United Nations Board of Auditors for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 July 1992.
