LETTER DATED 3 JANUARY 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF
PERU TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

I have the honour to refer to Note S-SPC/8/91 (1), concerning the resolutions adopted by the Security Council on the situation in Yugoslavia.

In this regard, I wish to inform you that Peru, faithful to the principle of respect for international obligations and adhering to the provisions of the Security Council resolution concerning the situation in Yugoslavia, will undertake the measures provided for therein and, in particular, the obligations set forth in paragraph 6 of resolution 713 (1991) to impose a general and complete embargo on all deliveries of weapons and military equipment to Yugoslavia.

I should be grateful if you would have this communication distributed as a document of the Security Council.
