Dear Sirs,

We hear that a fifth plebiscite may be going to take place in the Republic of Belau in the near future. I think there is not enough reason to call for it, as the will of the people in Belau to protect their nuclear-free Constitution has already been confirmed through a series of plebiscites and by the Belau Supreme Court. People should not be forced to carry out such a meaningless plebiscite.

I therefore request you to send an international observation team to evaluate the plebiscite procedure and to keep a careful eye on the political education programme to see if it has been carried out justly or not.
