NOTE VERBALE DATED 3 JANUARY 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT
REPRESENTATIVE OF PORTUGAL TO THE UNITED NATIONS
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of Portugal to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, with reference to the latter's note SCPC/8/91, dated 16 December 1991, has the honour to communicate to the Secretary-General those measures undertaken by Portugal to implement Security Council resolutions 713 (1991) and 724 (1991):

(a) The embargo was imposed by the European Community, following a decision made at a ministers' meeting on 5 July 1991.

(b) The texts of resolutions 713 (1991) and 724 (1991) were translated and sent out for publication in the official journal, "Diário da República", in order to ensure a broader dissemination of the measures approved by the Security Council.

(c) The aforementioned texts were distributed to the appropriate Public Administration departments (Ministry of Finance - Customs General Directorate, Ministry of Defense - General Directorate for Armament, Ministry of Commerce and Tourism - General Directorate for Foreign Trade), in order to prevent issuance of any licences for the export of goods to Yugoslavia.
