NOTE VERBALE DATED 3 JANUARY 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE  
OF GREECE TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of Greece to the United Nations has the honour to communicate to the Secretary-General, with reference to his note of 16 December 1991, the measures undertaken by the Government of Greece to implement Security Council resolutions 713 (1991) and 724 (1991).

The implementation of resolution 713 (1991) has been assured by decision of the Minister for Foreign Affairs published in the official Government Gazette (FEK 169/1991) together with the text of the said resolution and the necessary instructions to the competent authorities.

Greece also observes the European Community arms embargo on Yugoslavia imposed on 5 July 1991, which is based on the COCOM munitions list and covers all the main categories of military equipment. It should be noted that the embargo is applicable for contracts which had already been signed before its imposition as well as for delivery of spare parts, repairs of military equipment and transfer of military technology.

The competent Greek authorities have been alerted to the changes in the regulations necessitated by the imposition of the embargo and are paying close attention to all exports.

Greece is committed to implementing the embargo and maintaining very strict export controls for as long as it remains in force. Furthermore, Greece is committed to cooperating closely with the Committee of the Security Council established under Security Council resolution 724 (1991).
