NOTE VERBALE DATED 30 DECEMBER 1991 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION OF NORWAY TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of Norway to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, with reference to his note SCPC/8/91 of 16 December 1991, has the honour to communicate to the Secretary-General those measures undertaken by the Government of Norway to implement Security Council resolution 713 (1991) of 25 September 1991.

Pursuant to Act No. 4 of 7 June 1968 relating to the Implementation of Binding Resolutions by the United Nations Security Council, the Government adopted on 4 October 1991 regulations for the implementation of resolution 713 (1991). Paragraph 1 of the regulations states, in accordance with operative paragraph 6 of the resolution, that it is prohibited to deliver weapons or military equipment of any kind to Yugoslavia. This prohibition applies with no personal or territorial limitations other than those laid out in paragraphs 12 and 14 of the Norwegian Penal Act of 22 May 1902. According to paragraph 2 of the regulations, the latter entered into force immediately.
