NOTE VERBALE DATED 3 JANUARY 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION  
OF THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO  
THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Mission of the Russian Federation to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, with reference to Security Council resolution 724 (1991) of 15 December 1991, has the honour to state the following:

The Russian Federation has at the present time, with the support of the other members of the Commonwealth of Independent States, halted all forms of military and technical cooperation with Yugoslavia. Deliveries of weapons and military equipment, spare parts for them, accessories and technical industrial products, as well as of equipment and technical documentation for the organization of production of weapons and military equipment in Yugoslavia under licences previously transferred to it, have been completely discontinued. The acceptance for repair and return to Yugoslavia of repaired weapons and military equipment has also been discontinued. No technical assistance is being provided in the establishment of military facilities.

The above measures were put into effect by us in application of the provisions of Security Council resolution 713 (1991) of 25 September 1991 on the immediate implementation of a general and complete embargo on all supplies of weapons and military equipment to Yugoslavia.
