**SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS OF
WHICH THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND ON THE STAGE
REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION**

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in documents S/22110 of 28 January 1991, S/22110/Add.3 and Corr.1 of 1 February 1991, S/22110/Add.13 of 25 April 1991, S/22110/Add.21 of 22 July 1991, S/22110/Add.38 of 9 October 1991, S/22110/Add.39 of 22 October 1991 and S/22110/Add.47 of 9 December 1991.

During the week ending 7 December 1991, at its 3021st meeting, held on 5 December 1991, pursuant to resolution 708 (1991) of 28 August 1991, the Security Council proceeded to the election of a member of the International Court of Justice to fill the seat which had become vacant as a result of the death, on 14 August 1991, of Judge Taslim Olawale Elias.

In the course of the voting, Mr. Bola Ajibola (Nigeria) received the required absolute majority of votes in the Security Council.

As Mr. Bola Ajibola also received the required absolute majority of votes in the General Assembly, he was declared elected a member of the International Court of Justice for a term of office expiring 5 February 1994.

During the week ending 7 December 1991, the Security Council took no action on any of the items listed in documents S/22110 and addenda cited above.
