LETTER DATED 1 AUGUST 1980 FROM THE ACTING PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF PAKISTAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE
SECURITY COUNCIL

In my capacity as the representative of Pakistan, the current Chairman of the Organization of the Islamic Conference, I have the honour to draw your attention to paragraph 6 of Security Council resolution 476 (1980) of 30 June 1980 reaffirming the Council's determination, in the event of non-compliance by Israel with that resolution, "to examine practical ways and means in accordance with relevant provisions of the Charter of the United Nations to secure the full implementation" of the resolution.

In total disregard of the sentiments and the will of the international community and in flagrant violation of the Security Council resolutions including 476 (1980) regarding the specific status of the Holy City of Jerusalem, Israel, the occupying Power, has persisted in its designs to alter the status of the Holy City and according to the latest reports has enacted a law proclaiming the Holy City of Jerusalem as the capital of Israel.

In view of the serious and dangerous implications of the above-mentioned Israeli action and its consequences for world peace and security, I have the honour to request you on behalf of the member States of the Organization of the Islamic Conference, to convene an immediate meeting of the Security Council in terms of paragraph 6 of resolution 476 (1980).
