Letter dated 2 June 1987 from the Chargé d'affaires a.i. of the Islamic Republic of Iran to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

Upon instructions from my Government, I have the honour to inform you that, according to recently received information, in yet another instance of Iraqi war crime, on 7 May 1987 Iraqi warplanes dropped chemical bombs on the villages of Sarsool and Bolhassan in Baneh and, consequently, 92 civilians were injured. The wounded included civilians of all ages ranging from a two-year-old child to an 80-year-old woman.

It would be highly appreciated if this letter were circulated as a document of the General Assembly under item 62 of the preliminary list, and of the Security Council.
