Letter dated 11 June 1979 from the Acting Chairman of the Special
Committee against Apartheid to the Secretary-General

In accordance with the decision of the Special Committee at its 430th meeting, on 8 June 1979, I have the honour to transmit herewith, for the attention of the General Assembly and the Security Council, the summary record of the 429th meeting of the Committee, held on 6 June 1979, at which it heard experts from the United States, United Kingdom and Canada on bank loans to and investment in South Africa.**

The Special Committee wishes to take this opportunity to emphasize the importance of urgent action to stop all loans to South Africa in accordance with the relevant resolutions of the General Assembly.

I should be grateful if you would have this letter circulated as a document of the General Assembly, under item 28 of the preliminary list, and of the Security Council.
