NOTE VERBALE DATED 30 DECEMBER 1991 FROM THE PERMANENT
MISSION OF CHILE TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE
SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Mission of Chile to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to refer to note SCPC/8/91 (1), of 16 December 1991, concerning paragraph 6, subparagraph (a) of Security Council resolution 713 (1991) referring to a general and complete embargo on all deliveries of weapons and military equipment to Yugoslavia.

In connection with the foregoing, the Permanent Mission of Chile annexes Decree No. 1289, published in the Official Gazette on 21 December 1991.

MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS

Declares that the Government of Chile will fully implement resolution No. 713 of the United Nations Security Council imposing a general and complete embargo on all deliveries of weapons and military equipment to Yugoslavia.
No. 1,289. Santiago, 7 October 1991. Bearing in mind:

The provisions of the Political Constitution of the Republic, articles 32, No. 8 and 50, No. 1, and of the Charter of the United Nations, articles 25, 39, 41 and 48.

Considering:

That the United Nations Security Council, concerned about the hostilities in Yugoslavia, which threaten international peace and security, has issued resolution No. 713, of 1991, in which it imposes embargoes on that country.

That the Government of Chile considers it its duty to ensure the implementation of the resolutions adopted by the United Nations Security Council.

Decree:

Article 1: The Government of Chile shall fully implement resolution 713, of 25 September 1991, adopted by the United Nations Security Council, by virtue of which a general and complete embargo is imposed on all deliverance of weapons and military equipment to Yugoslavia.

Article 2: The relevant authorities and public bodies shall adopt all measures necessary for the fulfilment of the provisions of the preceding article.

Article 3: A full and authorized copy of the text of the resolution shall be published in the Official Gazette of the Republic of Chile.
