NOTE VERBALE DATED 6 JANUARY 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF IRELAND TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of Ireland to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, with reference to the latter's Note SCPC/8/91, dated 16 December 1991, has the honour to convey the following information to the Secretary-General in relation to the measures undertaken by Ireland to implement Security Council resolutions 713 (1991) and 724 (1991):

Since 5 July 1991, Ireland has implemented an embargo on exports of armaments and military equipment to the whole of Yugoslavia in accordance with the decision of the same date of the European Community and its member States. In consequence, no export licences have been issued since 5 July 1991 for the export or re-export to Yugoslavia of any item which might contravene this embargo.
