NOTE VERBALE DATED 30 DECEMBER 1991 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF CHINA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of the People's Republic of China to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, with reference to the latter's note SCPC/8/91(I) of 16 December 1991, has the honour to communicate to him the following information on the implementation of paragraph 6 of Security Council resolution 713:

In order to honour strictly the obligations set out in paragraph 6 of Security Council resolution 713 (1991) of implementing a general and complete embargo on all deliveries of weapons and military equipment to Yugoslavia, the Chinese Government formally issued on 9 October 1991 a circular which stipulated that all the relevant departments and companies engaged in arms trade in China shall, starting from the day of issuance of the circular, cease all deliveries of weapons and military equipment and spare parts for them to and all arms trade with Yugoslavia.

To date, all the relevant departments and companies engaged in arms trade in China have strictly implemented the stipulations issued by the Government.
