STATUS OF THE CONVENTION ON THE RIGHTS OF THE CHILD

Report of the Secretary-General

1. The General Assembly, by its resolution 44/25 of 20 November 1989, adopted the Convention on the Rights of the Child and expressed the hope that it would come into force at an early date. The Convention was opened for signature in New York on 26 January 1990 and, in accordance with article 49 thereof, entered into force on 2 September 1990, on the thirtieth day after the date of the deposit with the Secretary-General of the United Nations of the twentieth instrument of ratification or accession.
2. In its resolution 1991/52 of 6 March 1991, the Commission on Human Rights called upon all States that had not done so to sign, ratify or accede to the Convention as a matter of priority; recognized the important functions of the Committee on the Rights of the Child in overseeing the effective implementation of the provisions of the Convention; emphasized the importance of the strictest compliance by States parties with their obligations under the Convention; invited United Nations bodies and organizations as well as intergovernmental and non-governmental organizations to intensify their efforts with a view to disseminating information on the Convention and promoting its understanding; and requested the Secretary-General to submit a report on the status of the Convention on the Rights of the Child to the Commission at its forty-eighth session.

3. As at 16 December 1991, the Convention had received 133 signatures, 96 of which had been followed by ratification. In addition, 9 States had acceded to the Convention, bringing the total of ratifications and accessions to the Convention to 105. A list of States that have signed, ratified or acceded to the Convention, and the dates of their signature, ratification or accession, appears in the annex to the present report.

4. The first meeting of States Parties to the Convention was convened by the Secretary-General on 27 February 1991 at United Nations Headquarters in order to elect the members of the Committee on the Rights of the Child. The membership of the Committee for 1991-1993 is as follows:

5. The Committee on the Rights of the Child held its first session from 30 September to 18 October 1991 at United Nations Office at Geneva. At its first session, the Committee elected its officers and adopted its provisional rules of procedure (CRC/C/4), its general guidelines regarding the form and content of initial reports to be submitted by States parties under article 44, paragraph 1 (a), of the Convention (CRC/C/5) and its report (CRC/C/7).

6. In its resolution 46/112 of 17 December 1991, the General Assembly supported the organization of the future work of the Committee on the Rights of the Child on the basis of two sessions per year, each of two or three weeks duration, and the establishment of a pre-sessional working group for a preliminary review of reports from States parties; decided to take appropriate action on the recommendations of the Committee at the forty-seventh session of the General Assembly on the basis of the biannual report which the Committee is expected to submit to the General Assembly through the Economic and Social Council; invited the Secretary-General to convene a brief meeting of the States parties to the Convention, preferably during the forty-seventh session of the General Assembly, to determine the duration of the future meetings of the Committee on the Rights of the Child, prior to the consideration of the question by the Assembly; and invited the Secretary-General to consider favourably the possibility of enabling a working group of the whole of the Committee to meet in 1992.
