LETTER DATED 13 JANUARY 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT REFRESENTATIVE OF MEXICO TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Pursuant to the request contained in your note SCPC/8/91 (1), which refers to paragraph 5 (a) of Security Council resolution 724 (1991), I have the honour to inform you that the Government of Mexico, in keeping with its traditional policy of promoting general and complete disarmament, has no arms export industry and does not encourage or facilitate the sale or delivery of weapons and military equipment. Mexico has therefore complied fully with the provisions of Security Council resolution 713 (1991), and of its paragraph 6 in particular.
