I. BASIS OF ASSESSMENT OF MEMBER STATES' ADVANCES TO THE
WORKING CAPITAL FUND FOR THE BIENNIUM 1992-1993

Under its resolution 46/188 of 20 December 1991, the General Assembly resolved that:

"1. The Working Capital Fund shall be established for the biennium 1992-1993 in the amount of 100 million dollars;

"2. Member States shall make advances to the Working Capital Fund in accordance with the scale adopted by the General Assembly for contributions of Member States to the budget for the year 1992;

"3. There shall be set off against this allocation of advances:

"(a) Credits to Member States resulting from transfers made in 1959 and 1960 from surplus account to the Working Capital Fund in an adjusted amount of 1,025,092 dollars;

"(b) Cash advances paid by Member States to the Working Capital Fund for the biennium 1990-1991 under General Assembly resolution 44/204 of 21 December 1989;

"4. Should the credits and advances paid by any Member State to the Working Capital Fund for the biennium 1990-1991 exceed the amount of that Member State's advance under the provisions of paragraph 2 above, the excess shall be set off against the amount of the contributions payable by the Member State in respect of the biennium 1992-1993."

Under resolution 46/188 of 20 December 1991, the General Assembly resolved that the "Working Capital Fund shall be established for the biennium 1992-1993 in the amount of 100 million dollars". In accordance with paragraph 2 (d) of General Assembly resolution 46/221 A of 20 December 1991, the advances for the new Member States whose rates of assessment have not yet been incorporated in a 100.00 per cent scale of assessment are:

2. Contributions to the United Nations regular budget for the year 1991

The basis of assessment for the year 1991 was \$921,399,706 (being the amount assessed on Member States of \$1,086,366,466 less staff assessment income of \$164,966,760) under General Assembly resolution 45/252 C of 21 December 1990. Under resolution 46/221 A of 20 December 1991, the General Assembly resolved that the Member States concerned should be assessed only at the reduced regular rates shown below for the year of their admission; and that the contributions of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea and the Republic of Korea should be adjusted by one ninth of the flat fee paid for the participation in United Nations activities as a non-Member State for 1991.
