In paragraph 10 of the report, the Second Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of a draft resolution. The draft resolution was adopted by the Second Committee without a vote.

I also have the honour to introduce the report of the Second Committee (A/46/735) under agenda item 85, entitled "International assistance for the economic rehabilitation of Angola". In paragraph 11 of the report, the Second Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of a draft resolution. The draft resolution was adopted by the Second Committee without a vote.

Furthermore, the General Assembly has before it document A/46/738, under agenda item 88, entitled "Human resources development", in paragraph 9 of which the Second Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of a draft resolution, which was adopted without a vote.

Under agenda item 89, the Assembly has before it document A/46/739, entitled "Implementation of the commitments and policies agreed upon in the Declaration on International Economic Cooperation, in particular the Revitalization of the Economic Growth and Development of the Developing Countries". In paragraph 17 of the report, the Second Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of two draft resolutions, both of which were adopted without a vote.

The fifth report that I have the honour to present to the General Assembly is contained in document A/46/740, under agenda item 90, entitled "Industrial development cooperation and the diversification and modernization of productive activities in developing countries". In paragraph 10 of the report, the Second Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of a draft resolution, which was adopted without a vote.

Finally, I have the honour to introduce the report of the Second Committee (A/46/741) under item 91 of the agenda, entitled "Emergency assistance for the economic and social rehabilitation of Liberia". In paragraph 11 of that report, the Second Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of a draft resolution. The draft resolution was adopted by the Second Committee without a vote.

The PRESIDENT (interpretation from Arabic): If there is no proposal under rule 66 of the rules of procedure I shall take it that the General

Assembly decides not to discuss the reports of the Second Committee which are before the Assembly.

The PRESIDENT (interpretation from Arabic): Statements will therefore be limited to explanations of vote.

The positions of delegations regarding the various recommendations of the Second Committee have been made clear in the Committee and are reflected in the relevant official records.

May I remind members that under paragraph 7 of decision 34/401, the General Assembly agreed that:

"When the same draft resolution is considered in a Main Committee and in plenary meeting, a delegation should, as far as possible, explain its vote only once, i.e., either in the Committee or in plenary meeting, unless that delegation's vote in plenary meeting is different from its vote in the Committee."

May I remind delegations that, also in accordance with General Assembly decision 34/401, explanations of vote are limited to 10 minutes and should be made by delegations from their seats.

Before we begin to take action on the recommendations contained in the reports of the Second Committee, I should like to advise representatives that unless delegations have already notified the Secretariat to the contrary, we are going to take decisions in the same manner as was done in the Second Committee.

May I now invite the Assembly to turn its attention to the report (A/46/730) of the Second Committee on agenda item 80, entitled "International cooperation for the eradication of poverty in developing countries".

This draft resolution was adopted in the Second Committee without a vote.

May I take it that the Assembly wishes to do the same?

Draft resolution I was adopted (resolution 46/144).
