

NOTE VERBALE DATED 13 JANUARY 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF FIJI TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENER. 1

The Permanent Representative of the Republic of Fiji to the United Motions has the honour to refer to the Secretary-General's note of 10 December 1991 in which information on the measures instituted by Governments to meet the obligations set out in paragraph 6 of Security Council resolution 713 (1991) of 25 September 1991 was sought.

The Permanent Representative wishes to state that the Government of the Republic of Fiji has never purchased weapons nor traded in military equipment with Yugoslavia. It does not plan to do so in future, and will institute the necessary measures to ensure Fiji's conformity with paragraph 6 of Security Council resolution 713 (1991) of 25 September 1991.
