Declaration

In connection with the application of the Republic of Armenia for membership in the United Nations, I have the honour, on behalf of the Republic of Armenia and in my capacity as President, to declare that the Republic of Armenia accepts the obligations contained in the Charter of the United Nations and solemnly undertakes to fulfil them.
