ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBERS TO THE UNITED NATIONS

Letter dated 29 January 1992 from the President of the
Security Council to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to request you to transmit to the resumed forty-sixth session of the General Assembly the following resolution (resolution 737 (1992)) on the admission of the Republic of Uzbekistan to membership in the United Nations, adopted by the Security Council at its 3043rd meeting, on 29 January 1992:

"The Security Council,

"Having examined the application of the Republic of Uzbekistan for admission to the United Nations, 1/

"Recommends to the General Assembly that the Republic of Uzbekistan be admitted to membership in the United Nations."

I would point out that, when adopting the aforementioned resolution, the Security Council decided to have recourse to ~~the~~ provisions of ~~the~~ last paragraph of rule 60 of its provisional rules of ~~procedure~~ in order to submit its recommendation to the resumed forty-sixth ~~session~~ of the General Assembly.
