PROPOSED PROGRAMME BUDGET FOR THE BIENNIUM 1992-1993

Programme budget implications of draft resolutions VII, II, III and XIX adopted by the Third Committee in its report (A/46/721, paras. 102 and 103) and draft decision II

Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 51st and 52nd meetings, on 13 December 1991, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/46/58) on the programme budget implications of draft resolutions VII, II, III and XIX and draft decision II adopted by the Third Committee in its report (A/46/721, paras. 102 and 103). The related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions was presented orally by its Chairman.
2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/46/SR.51 and 52).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt:
 - (i) draft resolution VII an additional appropriation of \$400,000 would be required under section 31 and a decrease of \$34,000 under

section 28. The net appropriation of \$366,000 would constitute an additional expenditure derived from legislative mandates not provided for in the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1992-1993 and would therefore be subject to the guidelines for the use of the contingency fund approved by the General Assembly in its resolution 42/211 of 21 December 1987;

- (ii) draft resolutions II, III and XIX and draft decision II, no additional appropriation would be required.
