1. At its 46th meeting, on 7 December 1991, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/46/49) on the programme budget implications of the draft resolution recommended by the Special Political Committee in paragraph 14 of its report (A/46/640). The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.

2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/46/SR.46).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt the draft resolution recommended by the Special

Political Committee in paragraph 14 of its report, 1/ the modifications described in paragraphs 7 and 8 of the report of the Secretary-General 2/ would be required under the proposed programme of work for 1992-1993. It further decided to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt the draft resolution, it is not anticipated that additional appropriations would be required under the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1992-1993.
