NOTE VERBALE DATED 27 JANUARY 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF DJIBOUTI TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of Djibouti to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, with reference to his note SCPC/2/92 (1) of 28 January 1992, has the honour to inform him that the Government of Djibouti is complying strictly with the provisions of Security Council resolution 733 (1992) imposing a general and complete embargo on all deliveries of weapons and military equipment to Somalia.

Djibouti neither produces nor exports weapons or military equipment. It has never issued and will not issue in any form any authorization for the transport of military supplies to Somalia through its territory or from its territory.

The Permanent Representative of Djihouti to the United Nations welcomes the opportunity offered to him to contribute to the implementation of resolution 733 (1992).
