- (a) Portugal will fully comply with the present resolution, as it did in the case of previous arms embargoes imposed by the United Nations.
- (b) The text of the resolution was circulated among the competent Public Administration/departments (Ministry of Finance Customs General Directorate; Ministry of Defence General Directorate for Armament, and Ministry of Commerce and fourism General Directorate for Foreign Trade), in order to prevent issuance of any licences for the export of the above-mentioned goods to Somalia.
