NOTE VERBALE DATED 5 FEBRUARY 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT
REPRESENTATIVE OF PORTUGAL TO THE UNITED NATIONS
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of Portugal presents his compliments to the Secretary-General and, with reference to the latter's note SCPC/2/92(1) dated 28 January 1992, has the honour to communicate to the Secretary-General those measures undertaken by Portugal to implement Security Council resolution 733 (1992):

(a) Portugal will fully comply with the present resolution, as it did in the case of previous arms embargoes imposed by the United Nations.

(b) The text of the resolution was circulated among the competent Public Administration departments (Ministry of Finance - Customs General Directorate; Ministry of Defence - General Directorate for Armament, and Ministry of Commerce and Tourism - General Directorate for Foreign Trade), in order to prevent issuance of any licences for the export of the above-mentioned goods to Somalia.
