The Permanent Mission of Jordan to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, with reference to his vote SCPC/2/92(1) of 28 January 1992 concerning the measures instituted by the Jordanian Government in implementation of Security Council resolution 733 (1992) concerning the embargo on deliveries of weapons and military equipment to Somalia, has the honour to inform him that the Jordanian Government complies strictly with all Security Council resolutions, including the above-mentioned resolution, and wishes to state that Jordan does not manufacture weapons and undertakes to export neither weapons nor military equipment to Somalia.

In this connection, the Jordanian Government wishes also to express its unreserved support for the efforts made by the United Mations to achieve a peaceful settlement of the crisis in Somalia, and hopes that an end will thus be put to the conflict and the bloodshed in that fraternal country.

The Permanent Mission of Jordan takes this opportunity to convey to the Secretary-General the renewed assurances of its highest consideration.
