NOTE VERBALE DATED 6 FEBRUARY 1992 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES OF THE PERMANENT MISSION OF BRUNEI DARUSSALAM TO THE UNITED MATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Chargé d'affaires of the Permanent Mission of Brunei Darussalam to the United Nations presents her compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to convey the following message from His Highness Prince Mohamed Bolkiah, the Foreign Minister of Brunei Darussalam, to the Secretary-General in response to the latter's telex of 24 January 1992 concerning resolution 733 (1992) which was adopted unanimously by the Security Council on 23 January 1992.

"Thank you for your telem of 24 January 1992 concerning resolution 733 (1992) which was adopted unanimously by the Security Council on 23 January 1992.

"I take note of the resolution and wish to inform you that Brunei Darussalam has no military contact with Somalia. We support the various efforts of the United Nations Security Council in establishing peace and stability in Somalia, as outlined in the aforesaid resolution."
