NOTE VERBALE DATED 11 FEBRUARY 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION OF COTE D'IVOIRE TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Mission of Côte d'Ivoire to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, with reference to his note No. SCPC/2/92 (1), dated 28 January 1992, has the honour to inform him that Côte d'Ivoire neither manufactures nor exports weapons and military equipment.

Côte d'Ivoire therefore does not need to take any action in order to meet the obligations set out in paragraph 5 of Security Council resolution 733 (1992) concerning the embargo on deliveries of weapons and military equipment to Somalia.

Côte d'Ivoire, which is concerned at the deterioration in the situation in Somalia, supports all initiatives taken by the Security Council and the Secretary-General of the United Nations with a view to bringing peace and security to the African region concerned.
