**NOTE VERBALE DATED 3 FEBRUARY 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION
OF JORDAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE
SECRETARY-GENERAL**

The Permanent Mission of Jordan to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, with reference to his note SCPC/8/92(1) of 28 January 1992 concerning the measures instituted by the Jordanian Government in implementation of paragraph 6 of Security Council resolution 715 (1991) on the embargo on deliveries of weapons and military equipment to Yugoslavia, has the honour to inform him that the Jordanian Government is complying strictly with the above-mentioned Security Council resolution and all other resolutions on the situation in Yugoslavia, and wishes to state that Jordan does not manufacture weapons and undertakes not to authorize the export or delivery of weapons or military equipment to Yugoslavia.

The Permanent Mission takes this opportunity to convey to the Secretary-General the renewed assurances of its highest consideration.
