1. At its 53rd meeting, on 16 December 1991, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/46/69) on the programme budget implications of draft resolution II recommended by the Second Committee in its report (A/46/645/Add.6, para. 39). The Chairman of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions presented the Committee's report orally.

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

2. The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution II recommended by the Second Committee in its report, 1/ no additional appropriation would be required under section 1 (Overall policy-making, direction and coordination) of the programme budget for the biennium 1992-1993. It further decided to inform the General Assembly that the extent to which the Secretary-General would be able to respond to the requests contained in the draft resolution would depend upon his success in obtaining voluntary contributions for the related work.
