**Letter dated 4 February 1992 from the Minister for Foreign
Affairs of Honduras addressed to the Secretary-General**

I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your telex No. 1467, dated 24 January 1992, concerning resolution 733 (1992), adopted by the Security Council at its 3039th meeting on 23 January.

I wish to inform you in this connection that my Government shares your concern at the situation in Somalia and also resolutely supports your initiative designed to bring peace and stability to Somalia through the settlement of disputes by peaceful means, particularly the arms embargo that has been imposed.

As demonstrated by our possible participation in the United Nations Mission for the Referendum in Western Sahara, the concern of the Government of Honduras for peace extends beyond the boundaries of the American hemisphere, in this particular case to Africa.
