Letter dated 30 July 1987 from the Chargé d'affaires a.i. of the
Permanent Mission of Afghanistan to the United Nations addressed
to the Secretary-General

Upon instructions from my Government, I have the honour to bring to your attention the following.

Recently, the Pakistani authorities have alleged that on 7 and 10 July 1987, the armed forces of the Democratic Republic of Afghanistan attacked Ghazi and Chakara in Bajaur Agency.

After a thorough investigation, the competent authorities of the Democratic Republic of Afghanistan have found these allegations baseless and void of any truth, and therefore categorically reject them.

Once again the attention of the Government of Pakistan is drawn to the necessity of putting an end to such allegations, which could result in nothing but deterioration of the situation prevailing in the relations between the two countries.
