REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON THE ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBERS
CONCERNING THE APPLICATION OF THE REPUBLIC OF SAN MARINO
FOR ADMISSION TO MEMBERSHIP IN THE UNITED NATIONS

1. At the 3054th meeting on 21 February 1992, the Security Council had before it the application of the Republic of San Marino (S/23619) for admission to membership in the United Nations. In accordance with rule 59 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council and in the absence of a proposal to the contrary, the President of the Council referred the application to the Committee on the Admission of New Members for examination and report.
2. At its 86th meeting on 24 February 1992, the Committee considered the application of the Republic of San Marino and unanimously decided to recommend to the Security Council that the Republic of San Marino should be admitted to membership in the United Nations.
3. The Committee further decided to recommend to the Security Council that it should have recourse to the provision of the last paragraph of rule 60 of its provisional rules of procedure.
4. Accordingly, the Committee recommends to the Security Council the adoption of the following draft resolution:

The Security Council,

Having examined the application of the Republic of San Marino for admission to the United Nations (S/23619),

Recommends to the General Assembly that the Republic of San Marino be admitted to membership in the United Nations.
