I urge the United Nations to honour Palauan rights and that nation's efforts to defend its nuclear-free Constitution. As a United States citizen, I am urging my Ambassador to the United Nations to honour the United States' responsibilities under the Trusteeship Agreement, 1/ the Charter of the United Nations and the Declaration on the Granting of Independence to Colonial Countries and Peoples.

Ours is a world at risk. We must both recognize and applaud the efforts of nations and individuals who refuse to accept the madness of the arms race.
