In the light of the present situation on the Pacific island of Belau, the British Campaign for Nuclear Disarmament calls upon the Council to act with urgency to ensure that the wishes of the Belauan people are respected, that there are no more referenda and that there is an end to destabilization. We ask for a United Nations peace-keeping presence as requested by the traditional Chief of Belau and a full United Nations inquiry.
