COLOMBIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

I have the honour to refer to your note of 28 January 1992 in which you request information concerning the measures adopted by the Government of Colombia to comply with the provisions of paragraphs 5, 6 and 9 of resolution 733 (1992), adopted by the Security Council on 23 January 1992.

I wish to point out that Colombia does not export any weapons or military equipment and welcomes the adoption of resolution 733 (1992).

Furthermore, the Government of Colombia is stepping up contacts with public and private bodies in Colombia with a view to examining the possibility of contributing to the humanitarian assistance provided by the international community to the population of Somalia.
