LETTER DATED 21 FEBRUARY 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF ROMANIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Upon instructions from my Government, and with reference to your note verbale dated 29 January 1992 regarding the measures adopted by Romania pursuant to Security Council resolution 733 (1992), I have the honour to inform you that from the verifications undertaken it appears that Romania did not deliver to Somalia any weapons or military equipment in the period prior to the adoption of resolution 733 (1992). Immediately after the adoption of this resolution, measures have been taken for the strict observance by Romanian institutions of the general and complete embargo instituted by the Security Council on all deliveries of weapons and military equipment to Somalia.

I should be grateful if you would have the present letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
