NOTE VERBALE DATED 25 PEBRUARY 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF CANADA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of Canada to the United Nations presents her compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to note that, further to the adoption by the Security Council of resolution 733 (1992) on 23 January 1992, the Government of Canada has received no request nor issued any expert permit for weapons and military equipment to Somalia. Furthermore, the Canadian Government has not issued any permit for export to Somalia since late 1988 with the exception of an export permit for microwave equipment consigned to the technical assistance project of the International Civil Aviation Organization in Somalia (c/o of the United Nations Development Programme Office) in February 1990.

In view of Security Council resolution 733 (1992), the Canadian authorities will refrain from issuing any export permit for weapons or military equipment to Somalia until the United Nations Security Council decides otherwise.
