Message to the President of Mozambique from the Prime Minister of India

I have just seen your communiqué of 18 July.

On behalf of the Government and people of India and on my own behalf, I convey to you our deep sense of outrage at the dastardly massacre of a large number of innocent civilians, including children, by the MNR rebels. This act of naked terrorism, perpetrated with the encouragement and support of the racist Pretoria régime, deserves the strongest condemnation.

In your hour of grief, I reaffirm to Your Excellency and to the friendly people of Mozambique India's full solidarity with your valiant struggle to resist the forces of terrorism and destabilization operating with the active support of the apartheid régime of South Africa. As always, you can count on our support.
