LETTER DATED 13 AUGUST 1987 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES OF THE
PERMANENT MISSION OF IRAQ TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO
THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

On instructions from my Government and further to our repeated letters concerning the Iranian régime's assiduous pursuit of its series of criminal acts against our peaceful citizens through its iniquitous shelling of purely residential areas in Iraq, the most recent being the letter contained in document S/19028, I have the honour to inform you that, on 11 August 1987, the forces of this régime shelled residential neighbourhoods in the indomitable city of Basra and the town of Qala Diza, using long-range artillery. The enemy shelling resulted in the wounding of four civilian citizens and damage to a number of dwelling-houses and property belonging to civilian citizens in the town of Qala Diza.

I should be grateful if you would have this letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
