## Letter from the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Lithuania addressed to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to inform in addition to my previous letter responding to the resolution 733 (1992) adopted by the Security Council at its 3039th meeting, on 23 January 1992, that the Republic of Lithuania has never delivered weapons to any country of the world. There is no massive production of arms in Lithuania. Therefore Lithuania will not supply with weapons and military equipment any party involved in the conflict of Somalia.
