Note by the Secretary-General

1. By a communication dated 1 April 1987, addressed on behalf of the Secretary-General to the States parties to the Statute of the International Court of Justice, attention was drawn to the vacancy in the International Court of Justice caused by the death, on 10 March 1987, of Judge Guy Ladreit de Lacharrière (France). Pursuant to Article 5, paragraph 1, of the Statute of the Court, national groups of States parties to the Statute of the Court were invited to undertake the nomination of persons in a position to accept the duties of a member of the Court and to submit such nomination to the Secretary-General no later than 10 July 1987.
2. In accordance with Article 7 of the Statute of the Court, the Secretary-General has the honour to submit to the General Assembly and to the Security Council the name of the candidate thus nominated (see annex).
3. The composition of the Court and the voting procedure to be followed in the General Assembly and in the Security Council are contained in a memorandum by the Secretary-General issued as document A/41/1000-S/19018. The curriculum vitae of the candidate appears in document A/41/1003-S/19063.
